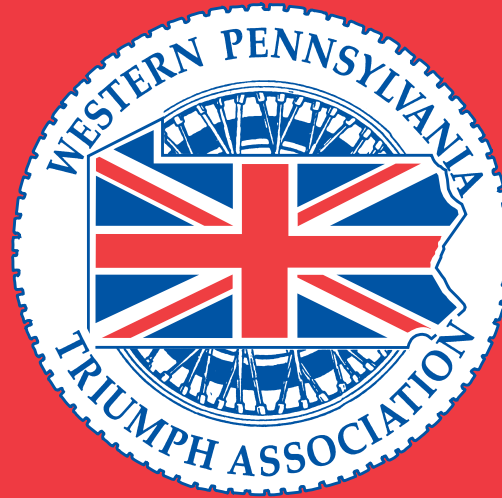

Schenley Park
Ground Rules:

- All vehicles must be driven onto the display area
- All vehicles will be parked in designated areas only, by order of arrival. Vehicles failing to display in proper class will be disqualified from judging.
- All vehicles must be in position by 12:00 noon. Late arrivals will be turned away.
- All vehicles must remain in position until 4 p.m. No movement is permitted between 12:00 noon and 4 p.m. All vehicles must vacate display area by 5 p.m.
- In the event of rain during the event, vehicles must remain in position until released by British Car Day officials.
- In the event of emergency requiring egress, a British Car Day official will escort you off the grounds.
- Commercial advertising and "For Sale" signs are prohibited. Authorized PVGPA "For Sale" signs may be purchased at the WPTA tent and displayed.
- The Western Pennsylvania Triumph Association reserves the right to modify or move field arrangement as required due to inclement weather.

\$30 per vehicle.
- No pre-registration after July 6:
Gate registration on space available basis:
\$40 per vehicle.
- Dash plaque for all pre-registered vehicles.

Awards:

- Every vehicle will be placed in a class and awards will be determined by popular vote on ballots provided to registered participants only.
- The Western Pennsylvania Triumph Association reserves the right to determine classes and to assign vehicles to them.
- We strongly urge you to pre-register by mail to help us determine class breaks and to assure your place on the field.

Sunday Car Display:

- British Car Day registration includes admission, on Sunday July 22, to the British car display. Admission from 9:30 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. at the British Car Day entrance on Darlington Road, same entrance as Saturday. Show your BCD windscreen card.
