- All vehicles must be in position by 12:00 noon. Late arrivals will be turned away.
- All vehicles must remain in position until 4 p.m. No movement is permitted between 12:00 noon and 4 p.m. All vehicles must vacate display area by 5 p.m.
- In the event of rain during the event, vehicles must remain in position until released by British Car Day officials.
- In the event of emergency requiring egress, a British Car Day official will escort you off the grounds.
- Commercial advertising and "For Sale" signs are prohibited. Authorized PVGPA "For Sale" signs may be purchased at the PVGPA tent and displayed.
- The Western Pennsylvania Triumph Association reserves the right to modify or move field arrangement as required due to inclement weather.

- One award for each class with at least three vehicles pre-registered.
- Two awards for each class with at least six vehicles pre-registered.
- Three awards for classes with nine or more vehicles pre-registered.
- Four awards for classes with fifteen or more vehicles pre-registered.
- The Western Pennsylvania Triumph Association reserves the right to determine classes and to assign vehicles to them.
