New E-mail System For WPTA

By now, you may or may not know of the new email list created for WPTA. I have struggled recently with maintaining email lists while trying to send appropriately timed emails and reminders of club events. We are in need of a better system to disseminate information to the Club besides the newsletter. With email being the choice of this age; we (WPTA) have adopted a system where everyone can send out an email to the rest of the club. You will need to "opt-in" to start receiving the emails (if you haven't already received them). It is to be ONLY used for club information. Such as club events, changes in schedules, impromptu events and similar information.

This system is run by Mark Bradakis of Utah, who runs the email networks of "autox.team.net" for the Triumph lists, MG lists, AH lists, FOT list, and etcetera. There is no charge; it is by donation only, so WPTA will donate a set amount each year for the list. Then it is up to you, the members, to donate on an "as you feel" basis. Mark, by no means is getting rich off of these lists; but he does supply one heck of a great service to all the British Marques. The system is secure, your email is never made public, and safe, the system doesn't allow for any attachments to be sent (if you do send one it will be deleted).

If you haven't seen the "wpta@autox.team.net" emails, send me an email to "opt-in" to this service, and then you will be able to send and receive emails to and from the others in the system. Once again, this will be limited to club information only. DO NOT "REPLY" TO THESE EMAILS unless you need to contact the entire club!

We have approximately 180 members, I will automatically send the 110 or so current members that I have working emails for. You may "opt-out" at any time if you like. You will receive a monthly email with information about the account.






