Slot Car Racing

Mark your calendars. Saturday, March 5, 2016 will be our 4th annual slot car event.

There are several diehard club members that insist we race slot cars on the first Saturday in March. Those of you who have participated in the past know the drill. If you have never attended this event, here is the lowdown.

We will meet at Perkins in Cranberry at 9:00 am for breakfast. We will then depart (caravan) for my house in Poland, Ohio. The drive will take about 45 minutes so we will arrive at approximately 11 am. If you want to skip breakfast just arrive at my place (7921 Cliffview Dr. Poland, OH 44514) around 11 am prepared to get your "race face" on.

The track is a 115 foot, hand routed MDF (medium density fiberboard), 4 lane circuit. The hand controllers have adjustable throttle and brake sensitivity. This year I have specially constructed four 1/24 scale, 1970 Camaros for this event. These cars meet the most important criteria for the event-they are indestructible. Unskilled slot racers crash—a lot. In past years the cars we raced took a real beating. The Camaros' will be perfect cars for this event, fun and almost unbreakable. I say almost because based on what I have witnessed in past years some drivers can break an unbreakable car. The track also has computer management that gives lap times to the thousandth of a second.

Most important is proper etiquette when racing slot cars. Do: sip your favorite beverage, question the manhood of your competitors, keep your car in the slot, have fun. Don't: expect to beat me (skills), just ask Ken about that, set your controller on the track, lay your hand on the track (ouch). It is that simple.




